

## St Michael Parish Ministries - Time and Talent

The following are current volunteer needs within the parish. If you are currently serving in a ministry, check the box(es) marked "C" to indicate that you will continue serving in this ministry or "I" if you are interested in learning about this ministry. Ministries with only an "I" next to them mean there is currently no one serving in that ministry. Please indicate the family member next to selection.

### Administration

- [I] [C] Finance Council - looking for people with business/finance background. Meetings are 1 time per month for an hour.
- [I] [C] Stewardship Council - making Stewardship a way of Life within the parish. One meeting a month Sept to May for about an hour.
- [I] [C] Volunteering in the Office - Make your own hours helping with various office tasks as needed.
- [I] Writing for Quarterly Newsletter - Volunteers needed to write for the quarterly newsletter on a variety of topics.
- [I] Taking Photos at Parish Events - volunteers needed to take a few photos at various parish events.

### Liturgy

- [I] [C] Worship Commission- learn more about the processes of the Mass. Meetings are never more than once a month.
- [I] Church Decorating Committee - **NEW**-group of volunteers to decorate church for ordinary time and holidays. Time to be determined.
- [I] [C] Lector - one hour training, then rotating schedule based on the Mass you normally attend. Teens needed for Life Teen Mass
- [I] [C] Eucharistic Minister - 1hr training, then rotating schedule based on your normal Mass. Teens needed for Life Teen Mass
- [I] [C] Altar Server - 1hr training, then rotating schedule based on your normal Mass. Teens needed for Life Teen Mass
- [I] [C] Hospitality Ministers (usher/greeters) - 1hr training, then rotating schedule based on your normal Mass. Teens needed for Life Teen Mass.
- [I] [C] Sacristan - 1hr training, then rotating schedule based on your normal Mass.
- [I] [C] Music Ministry - if you play an instrument or sing, join us! Teens needed for Life Teen Mass. 1 rehearsal weekly and before Mass.

- [I] Faith Formation Commission -NEW- facilitate cooperation and communication among various adult formation programs.
- [I] [C] Bible Study - meets Friday at 10am
- [I] [C] Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
- [I] [C] Returning Catholics - Group meets January to March 1x a week for 1.5 hours
- [I] [C] Adult Enrichment Committee- works to enrich adult faith life. Meets every other month
- [I] [C] Social Justice - Just Faith program and Crossing Borders. Meets every other month

### **Parish Life**

- [I] [C] Monthly Coffee and Donuts - Host one Sunday. Pick up donuts and serve. Any group/family in the parish is welcome.
- [I] 39er's Luncheon - 2 clean-up people needed 2nd Wednesday each month. Clean-up from 1- 2:30 or come first for lunch at 12.
- [I] [C] Welcoming Committee- volunteers to help make new parishioners welcome. Meets every few months.
- [I] Parish Picnic Planning Committee-**NEW**- volunteers needed to put together picnic each September. Group to decide time commitment

### **Children and Youth Programs**

- [I] 2 teachers for 3rd and 4th grade. Teach each Sunday 9:30-10:30, 1 meeting monthly.
- [I] [C] Substitutes for Religious Education on Sundays-teach the lesson left by the teacher. 1 hour on the occasional Sunday
- [I] 5 teacher helpers to assist the teachers on Sunday Mornings - assist teachers 9:30 to 10:30 Sundays. Teens welcome.
- [I] Person to assist Hilary Melander on Sunday mornings to make sure that parents' questions are answered. Sunday 9:30 to 10:30
- [I] Photographer- experienced photographer to take First Communion pictures at the 3 masses on May 21st and 22nd.

### **Spiritual Enrichment**

- [I] [C] Cursillo (Men's and Women's retreats)- held during the year for spiritual growth
- [I] [C] Prayer Groups- Rosary Prayer Group - Wednesday 7:30 pm in library and Spanish Prayer Group - Friday 7pm in Small Hall

### **School Volunteer Opportunities**

- [I] [C] School Commission- this requires a three year commitment with meetings once a month Aug-June
- [I] [C] Fundraising Committee
- [I] [C] Ad Hoc Committee- members needed to work on assigned projects until completion
- [I] [C] Playground monitors- volunteers needed to help monitor the playground at recess
- [I] [C] Lunchtime monitors- volunteers needed to assist during lunch time

### **Other Ministries**

- [I] [C] Funeral Food Committee - drop off a dessert or salad for the funeral. Time is as needed.
- [I] [C] Funeral Reception Committee- volunteers needed to help serve and clean-up after the funeral reception. Time is as needed.
- [I] [C] Knights of Columbus-
- [I] [C] Building Maintenance & Repairs- the parish needs volunteers to help in various areas. If you are a plumber, electrician, painters, handymen, carpenters, etc. These people would be called occasionally to help maintain the parish buildings according to their talent.
